

# finding your way...

Keele University is easy to get to. The campus is located on the outskirts of the market town of Newcastle Under Lyme, 15 minutes from Junction 15 & 16 of the M6, and easily accessed from M6 toll road, M1, A34 and A50.

## Road

The University is easily accessed from the Midlands network of motorways. A map can be obtained from your event organiser, or you can download our visitor map as a PDF from our website: [www.keele-conference.com](http://www.keele-conference.com).



## From North & South M6 Motorway

1. Exit at J16
2. Take the exit at the roundabout, signposted A500, Keele University.
3. At the next 2 roundabouts take the 1st exit, signposted A531 and A525, Keele.
4. At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit (straight ahead), signposted A531 & A525, Keele.
5. Continue along this road through the villages of Betley & Madeley Heath.
6. From here the University is signposted (Note: Guests visiting Keele Management Centre can take one of two exits for Keele village. The management centre is situated in the centre of the village).

## From North & South M1 Motorway

1. Leave the M1 at junction 23A, then merge onto the A453 (signposted A453 East Midlands, Stoke, Derby).
2. At roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A453 (signposted Nottingham, Derby).
3. At roundabout take the 1st exit onto the A50 (signposted Stoke, Derby).
4. Continue forward onto the A50. Entering Stoke on Trent.
5. Continue forward through tunnel (signposted City Centre, Newcastle).
6. Continue forward onto the A50 (signposted Newcastle, M6).
7. At roundabout take the 1st exit, then merge onto Queensway - A500 (signposted Stone, Newcastle A34, M6).
8. Branch left (signposted Newcastle-under-Lyme, Stone), then at roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Stone Road; A34 (signposted Newcastle-under-Lyme).
9. Continue forward onto London Road; A34. Entering Newcastle-under-Lyme.
10. At Grosvenor roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Lower Street; A34 (signposted Congleton).
11. At roundabout take the 1st exit onto Blackfriars Road; A53 (signposted Shrewsbury).
12. At traffic signals turn right onto Blackfriars Road; A519 (signposted Whitchurch)
13. At traffic signals continue forward onto the A525 (signposted Whitchurch)
14. At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Keele Road; A525 (signposted Whitchurch)
15. At roundabout take the 1st exit and follow signs for Keele University

## Public transport

Buses from Stoke-on-Trent Station:

First Buses operate a number of services.

Buses from Crewe Station: D&G buses

to Newcastle (No. 85A service) leave from

the stop to the right of the station entrance towards the roundabout.

The Sunday service is the two hourly Baker Bus Service 85A.

Services from Euston to Crewe run approximately every 20 minutes. The journey time is approximately 2 hours.

Services from Birmingham to Stoke-on-Trent run approximately every 30 minutes. The journey time is approximately 1 hour.

Services from Manchester to Stoke-on-Trent run approximately every 15 minutes. The journey time is approximately 45 minutes.

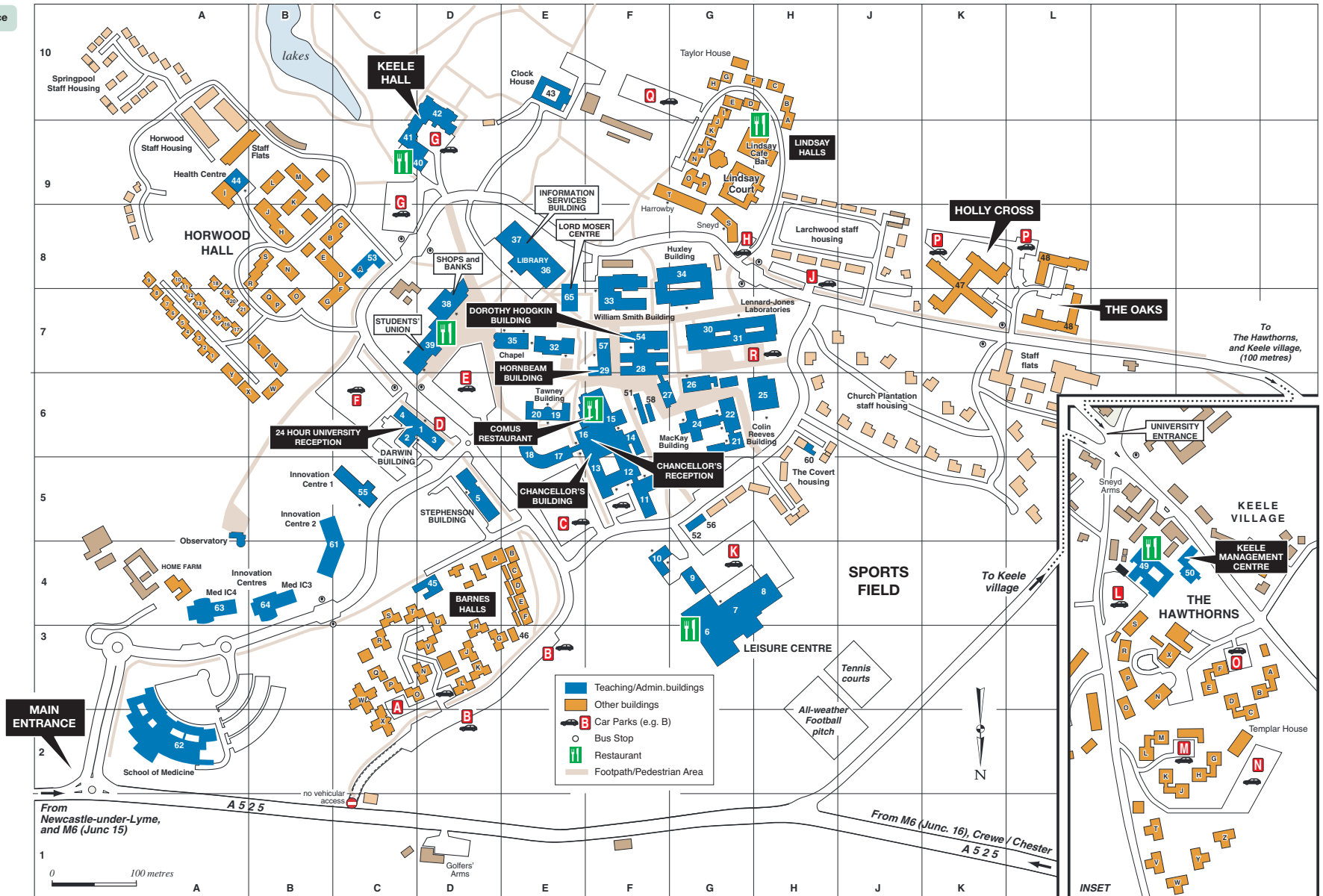
